Consequences

God disciplines us for our own good that we may share in His holiness. No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it. **Hebrews 12:10-11**



Each child will start on green (good) behavior. If they are not able to follow the rules, they will receive the following warnings and consequences:

- Yellow (first warning) – child is reminded of the rule
- Red (second warning) – child is removed from the situation to either another area in the room or to sit next to a teacher or assistant
- Black (third warning) – child (or teacher) writes a note to be given to the parent
